

Code of Conduct for Parents/Carers

In order to participate in White Rose Junior Chess Academy events, parents are expected to:

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of each and every person and treat each equally.
2. Ensure that the children are aware of and adhere to the expectations of them in terms of behaviour (See Code of Conduct for Players)
3. Not attempt to exert undue influence on the result of a game or on any other decision affecting play (e.g. board order in team events)
4. Abide by, and teach children to abide by, the decisions of the arbiters and tournament organisers.
5. Raise any concerns about any aspect of a tournament promptly and constructively with the tournament organiser and abide by the subsequent decision of the organiser.
6. Consistently display high standards of behaviour
7. Not use or tolerate inappropriate language.
8. Respond promptly to any concern about the welfare of a child by reporting it to the organisers of the event.
